July 21, 1933 - April 1, 2021

Bach, Charles Joseph “Joe” of Clinton Twp., MI peacefully passed away at home on Thursday, April 1, 2021 at the age of 87. Born in Dayton, OH to parents Charles Francis & Pauline Dolores (Macke) Bach, was the first of five children and grew up in Dayton, OH. Graduated from Chaminade High School in 1951. Graduated from General Motors Institute (GMI) of Flint, Michigan in 1956 with a Bachelor’s in Business Administration, where he was a member of the Phi Sigma Phi Fraternity. At his beginnings with GM, he worked at Inland where he met his wife, the love of his life Phyllis. In December 1978, Joe took a job transfer, moving his family from Ohio to Michigan. For 40 years Joe worked his way up in GM to Director of Data Processing Operations.

He loved being a husband for 65 years, a father and raising their four daughters. Joe was an avid golfer up until his 80’s, enjoyed paint by numbers, puzzles, wood working and most of all, investing. He volunteered as a first responder at Stonecrest, their gated community in Florida until they permanently moved to Lake Port Square Retirement Community in Leesburg, Florida in 2015.

His life was centered around his Catholic faith, love of God, family and friends. Joe & Phyllis were members of St. Kieran’s Catholic Church of Shelby Twp. for over 35 years, where Joe was a Knights of Columbus member and an usher.

Joe assisted Phyllis in starting an Essential Tremor support group in central Florida that grew from 6 to several hundred, helping many with the disease as well as their caregivers. He is survived by his children: Debbie Frederick, Mary Ann (John) Bral-Vadalabene, Nancy Willoughby, and Kathleen Bach; daughter-like family friend Tyra Bradley; 10 grandchildren and 10 great-grandchildren; siblings Tom (Pat) Bach, Bob (Betty Rienstra) Bach, Shirley Adams, and Doug (Mary) Bach.

Preceded in death by his wife Phyllis Bach; sister-in-law Magdalene Murray Bach; and son-in-law Charles Bishoping III.
