I know how proud you are of each of them, because whenever I saw you, THEIR highlights were the stories you told with a delighted exuberance. From their early dance careers to excelling in school, you beamed with pride when listing their accomplishments.

Unfortunately, time is a cruel thing, as there is never enough – and our individual priorities took us in different directions. Promises to get together were seldom fulfilled. But always know that the memories we shared will last forever. Although way too young, I believe you are in a better place now. You will be truly missed, my friend.
