WOLF, Hugo R. September 14, 2022. Age 91.

Hugo Robert Wolf was born on the 21st of February, 1931, on Harding St. in the heart of the German immigrant community in Detroit, Michigan, as the 2nd son of Karl and Anna (Bauer) Wolf. The family relocated to Neuhausen auf den Fildern, Württemberg, Germany in 1933. After living through the 2nd World War in Germany, he returned to Detroit in 1950. Active duty in the U.S. Navy on the U.S.S. Salem during the Korean War. Trained as a tailor in Germany, he embarked on a successful 47-year career with the J.L. Hudson Company and later with Niemann Marcus.

In 1957, he married Donata Maria (Flammann), with whom he would celebrate 54 happy years of marriage and raise three sons. He was a loving husband, father and grandfather, dedicated to his wife and caring for her tirelessly during an extended illness before her untimely passing in 2011. He was involved in the Catholic Community of St. Veronica in East Detroit, as an active father and member of the Bach Choir, and in the German immigrant community in the Metro Detroit area, celebrating over 70 years of membership in the Schwäbischer Männerchor. He loved gardening, music, dancing, and celebrations with family and friends.

He is survived by his three loving sons, Bryan Josef, Steven Mark (Judith), and Eric Paul (Jacqueline), and by his two grandsons, Karl (Kelly), and Ryan, to whom he was a loving and doting Opa; by his brothers, Karl and Werner in Neuhausen, Germany, and many nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents and his oldest brother, Walter.
