Enrolled at Wayne State University in 1969, 20 years after graduation from High School of Commerce, Jane earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Education in 1975. She earned her Masters degree in 1979. Jane taught Business Education at Hamtramck High School for 20 years - from 1975 until 1995. In addition, she taught Business Education for nine years at Oakland Community College, Auburn Hills campus.

Jane's hobbies were many: crochet and knit needlework, sewing, basketry, gardening, watercolor painting, bowling, golf and collecting Depression glassware.

Jane is survived by her husband of 56 years; Alex Garanzini. Two sisters, Irene Alex and Teresa Basile (Frank); Five children, Paul Szczesny (Kathy), James Szczesny (Kathleen), Nancy Kinnee (John), David Szczesny, and Michael Garanzini (Tricia); Eight grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.
