The time you grounded me while I was over for a sleepover. I deserved it. I was being a punk. I think you felt bad for grounding me so you ended up making sausage and peppers for Matt and I later that night. It was almost worth getting grounded for that.

You had just given me my first job at State Barricades and Matt and I were screwing around. Shocker. We decided it would be a good idea to put a hammer into the rivet machine to see what would happen. Well the handle shattered into a million pieces of course. Mr. Mollicone, you got pretty mad at us that time around. So mad you docked my pay for the hammer and made us fill sandbags for the rest of the week. I learned a lot about hard work those 2 summers and also what a hard worker you were.

The time I traveled with you and Matt to Ohio for a soccer tournament and I broke my ankle in the final. You always took good care of me on these roadtrips, but you took especially good care of me at the hospital and on the ride home. I felt terrible for losing in the final (2-1 remember it like yesterday) and I was also in a lot a pain. You and Matt cheered me up, set up a "bed" for me in the Astro van and never made me feel like a drag. My mom felt terrible for not being able to be there but I think she felt assured knowing I was with you.

Thank you Mr. Mollicone. I cannot express that deeply enough. Thank you for being there for my family and for me. You always treated me really well, which sometimes meant putting me in my place. I needed that though so I'm forever grateful and please know you'll be missed by the Jeakles.
