Marge was born Margaret Mary Morris in her parents' home in Detroit, MI on June 10, 1930. She left public school in 10th grade to go to work at Yankee Girl Potato Chip Factory to help out with the household finances. However, that fact always bothered her, so, she went back to school in the 1970s in Southfield, Michigan to complete her education and graduated with a 4.0 average!

She is mainly of Polish decent, her mother having immigrated legally from Poland at the age of 19. Her father was of Polish and Hungarian decent.

She worked at Hudson's in Southfield at their restaurant; then was hired by Southfield Public Schools in the cafeteria as a food server in many of the schools; first as a "Sub", and then finally full time at Thompson Jr. High. Her position as "Head Cook" was eliminated so she chose to move on to a better position in custodial. She loved to clean, so it was a great natural "jump". She retired after 30 years, but being "bored" she went back "part-time" for a few more years.

She loved gardening (and sharing fresh canned tomatoes every year,) sitting on her patio swing reading, going to the casino and horse race track with her husband John, and driving along for short trips in her much loved Ford Focus, among many other vehicles she owned. She simply adored all of her grandkids and great-grandkids, and always looked very much to having them "spend the night" and just hang out with her and "Grampa John."

To her family and friends she was the best cook ever, especially of her passed-down recipes of Polish foods; Kielbasa, Pirogi, and Stuffed Cabbages, also known as "Goomkies."

She loved visiting an occasional "lady friend" until most of them moved on in one way or another, and visiting family. She was a great neighbor to all. As of late, because of life circumstances, she became not only Mother and Daughter, but also great friends with her daughter Sherry (Cheryl)

She was a dynamic presence, and will be greatly and sadly missed by all; but she is at rest and free from pain and life's sadness. She is dancing once again with her husband, John.
