In 2011 at the Detroit Autorama Al was inducted into the coveted "Circle of Champions". In 2011 at the Concours d'elegance of America show at St. Johns Inn, Al became the first person to have a registered class (Muscle Cars) to bear his name. Al will always be remembered for his great memory. He had GM parts numbers stuffed everywhere in his head. So much so that in the 80's, Super Chevy Magazine did a story about him and some of his rare engines. We could share Al
