Carol Lou Wright (Minguske) passed away at age 80 surrounded by family on June

Carol and John created beautiful memories. Some of their longer trips included Albuquerque for a hot air balloon festival, road trips to Florida and the badlands, an Alaskan cruise, and two trips to Hawaii - one with her sister and her husband.

They visited Michelle and Paul in Germany and Washington State, Mark and Lori in Washington DC, and Sue and Chuck in San Diego. She took joy in simple things and had an amazing green thumb. Their yard and home were filled with beauty and John continues that passion.
