“ I remember the first birthday party that my mother Marion and Aunt Geri put together for my sister Theresa and nephew Sammy in the summer of 1944. The entire Fodale family lived in a big house at 2135 McClellan in Detroit across from the police station. Grandma and Grandpa Fodale slept in in library converted into a bedroom on the first floor. Sammy and Aunt Geri had the front upstairs bedroom while Aunt Eva had one of the back bedrooms. My mother, brother Dennis, sister Theresa and I had the other back bedroom which was connected to a rear kitchen. Uncle Joe, Uncle Tony and my dad Frank were all in the army. They all survived World War II without any injury. They are gone now except for Sammy, Theresa and me. I remember Aunt Geri and Uncle Tony's first upper flat on Anderdon in Detroit where Aunt Geri taught me how to play gin rummy which I play to this day. I remember Aunt Geri, Uncle Tony, Sammy and Anthony living above us in the upper flat at 567-569 Dickerson in Detroit. I remember their Christmas Eve parties which continued when they moved to St. Clair Shores. I remember that Aunt Geri introduced me to pickled herring which is still one of my favorite treats.
