James Lilburn Halley Jr. Passed away at the age of 83 due to a glioblastoma. James was born to the late James and Marie Halley on June 25, 1938 in Reading, PA. He grew up in Milwaukee, WI and was the dearest brother of the late Marjorie (Philip) Piano. James joined the United States Army in 1956 for six years, four of which he served as an Army medic. He graduated from the University of Wisconsin in 1965 with a Bachelor of Science degree. James started his civilian career with Caterpillar where he excelled with overseas assignments including two years in Geneva, Switzerland and four years in Madrid, Spain. Upon return to the US, his adventurous career assignments included California, Wisconsin, Illinois, Florida, and Michigan. His culminating career accomplishment was establishing the US division of Centa. He was an avid reader, writer, traveler, history buff, airplane enthusiast, and member of the Society of Naval Architects and Marine Engineers.

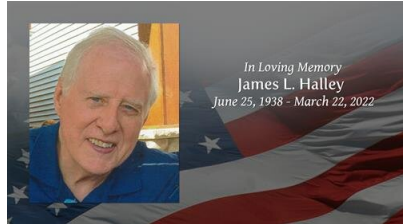

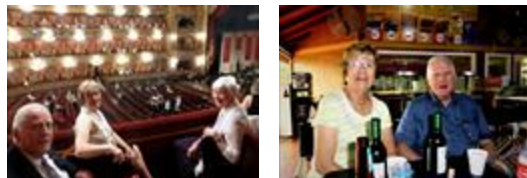
