Kathleen was also an active member of the St. Isadore parish, serving on the Altar Society for 10 years, where she formed friendships and enjoyed participating in many service activities, including the annual Strawberry Festival, rummage sale, bake sales and cake walks. She also lived her faith through outreach activities to evangelize others, actively praying for the Holy Souls in Purgatory and taking part in missions to help feed and clothe the poor and underserved.

Her heart was especially full when spending time with family, friends and neighbors – siblings, children, grandchildren, spouses, friends, nieces, nephews and extended family.
