“Our Mantey family crossed town regularly to visit the Wujeks over the years. I have early memories of the Peyton house, where we'd see cousins Ken and Bob, Uncle Syl, Grandma Jaeger (mother of Jane and Margaret), usually the Kaye family, with their kids Mark and Diane, and sometimes Uncle Syl's sister Helen. Aunt Margaret always greeted us with sparkling eyes, and we'd smell Grandma's homemade bread from the kitchen. We'd sit and talk in the living room before having a casual meal. Then card games with snacks, and sometimes piano boogie and dancing in the basement, especially when Ken's friend Milt was around. In the 1950s and 60s, Margaret was Office Manager for a company that developed and sold products to car makers. She was a very energetic office manager who kept 3 or 4 sales guys in-line. Margaret handled bookkeeping, telephones, customer service, correspondence and office technology. She embraced word processing early on, followed by computers, email and the internet. The Wujeks often traveled to the Mantey house in Southfield for celebrations. A Harvey/Aunt Margaret combined birthday was celebrated each July. There was Peanuts/Pinochle card play, group singing, and cousins and kids connecting. These events slowed in later years, but in the summer of 2009, an amazing thing happened a July birthday party expanded into a Mantey/Wujek reunion with extended families at Marge and Tim's house in Howell, MI! Following the joy of that togetherness, we began to lose the generation with the passing of Harvey, Syl, Jane, and finally, Margaret. I admire the way my mom and her sister were devoted to family. I love them and know they'll always be with me.”
