(12/16/56) Passed away peacefully on September 20, 2025 after a courageous battle with pancreatic cancer. He is survived by his beloved wife, Cindy, with whom he enjoyed 42 years of marriage. 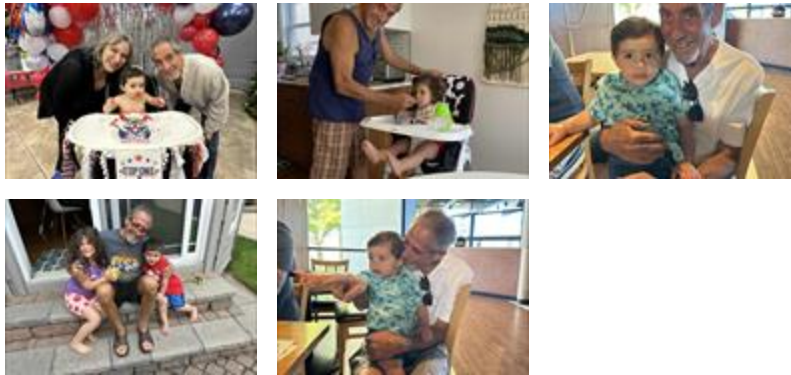
