Peter passed away on May 1, 2026, in Dallas, Texas from complications following a stroke, leaving behind a life defined by adventure, connection, and love.

He was a proud uncle to five nieces and four nephews, and a great-uncle to three great-nieces, one great-nephew, and two more on the way. He also leaves behind his loyal Old English Sheepdog, Bruno, who was always faithfully by his side.

Peter was also known for the family he created beyond blood. Through his restaurant, Alfonso's Italian Restaurant in Dallas, which he established in 1982, he built a community that felt more like home than a workplace. Over the years, his entire staff became like family to him. He cared about them deeply and stayed connected to so many of them over the years.

A graduate of Fraser High School, Class of 1973, Peter carried his roots with him no matter where life led. His adventurous spirit and love of travel took him

across the world, including Thailand, where he met the love of his life, Pim. Thailand also held a special place in his heart and became his second home.

But more than anything, Peter will be remembered for how he made people feel. He had a way of bringing everyone together: whether it was an impromptu ice cream run, a pizza night, or simply calling up friends and family when he was in town. He didn't wait for special occasions, he created them. He understood that the best moments in life are the ones shared.

Peter's life was full - full of laughter, full of connection, and full of love. His legacy lives on in the family he cherished, the friendships he nurtured, and the countless lives he touched along the way.
