Dr. Robert Adam Delp. Age 71. Devoted husband of Johanna for 48 years, passed Saturday, June 13, 2015. Born in Detroit, Robert attended Grosse Pointe High School and was a graduate of Wayne State University School of Medicine. A dedicated doctor to his patients, he practiced for 38 years in Michigan prior to relocating to Florida, where he continued to practice medicine at the Lowell Correctional Institution.
