I owed Hutch some money and I have two books that belonged to him. He had two books of mine and some collateral for the money I owed. He was a gem of a guy and I really would like to repay his family. We went to the Derby City Classic pool tournament (in 2008, I think) and also to the 2012 U.S. Open 9-Ball Tournament, in October 2012. The collateral he held included the following items: Two 2-piece cues and cases (a Viking cue in a blue vinyl Viking case and a Mike Sigel cue in an inexpensive zippered case), my old white gold, black faced Longine watch with a Twist-o-Flex band, my gold wedding band (with 7 columns each containing 3 chips, a chip was missing from one of the columns), my gold black onyx ring with a synthetic emerald on it, and finally, my ex-wife's gold necklace with some colored stones on it. I visited him once at home in 2009 or so and I seem to recall that he had my cues in the living room somewhere at that time. I don't know where he may have stored my jewelry.
