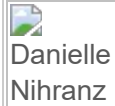

We send our love and condolences to her family and prayers for healing.

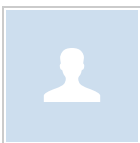

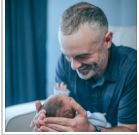
