Thomas DeOliveira, 83, of Roseville, Michigan, passed away peacefully on February 18, 2026 surrounded by his loving family.

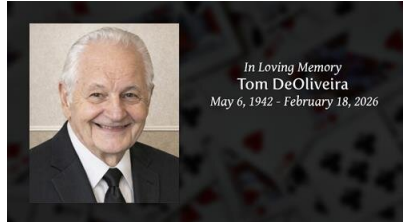
