*Grace and I were neighbors to Don and Marie Soule on Collingham street in Detroit for a considerable number of years and we had the great pleasure to meet Bill, yourself and the children, and they were tots at the time, when you would come to visit. Your Mother in Law, Marie (and grandmother) was a wonderful person who befriended us early on after we moved in and she became a second grandmother to our children, especially Patrick, at the time, our youngest. Grace would constantly be looking out the front door to keep track of the children and invariably Patrick would be at Mrs. Soules. It became such a habit that Marie made a cardboard sign that said "Patrick is here" and placed it in her window that was directly opposite our kitchen window so Grace would know where he was. I think the fact that she always provided him with cookies may have been a factor in his visits inside the house.*

*I was a Detroit Police Officer at the time and Bill and I had a number of concerns in common and enjoyed kicking around our common problems. I was also an instructor at Wayne State University while I was employed with the DPD so, at Marie's funeral, it gave us another topic of mutual interest to talk about. It was much too early for Bill to leave this earth, leaving behind a family he obviously loved dearly but this insidious disease does not pick on only the young, it is relentless. Having read the numerous comments left by those who knew Bill better than I, he obviously touched many, many lives in a very positive manner. Don and Marie were good people and it is obvious the manner in which they raised their two sons rubbed off on them.*
